Journalist, ex Advisor of the President of the Republic of Croatia for Social Affairs

Born in Zagreb, Croatia, Zrinka Vrabec-Mojzes graduated from the Faculty of Philosophy at the University of Zagreb, in Art History and English language and literature, and holds a PHD in information and communication sciences from Faculty of Philosophy at the University of Zagreb an degree of Master of Sciences of International Relations on the Faculty of Political Sciences in Zagreb. She started a career in journalism in 1984 as a student in Culture Department of the then newly-established Radio 101. During following decade she worked in all aspects of journalism, including editor, anchor, producer and reporter. From 1985-1995 as a free lancer she worked in a variety of Departments of Croatian Television. From 1995-1998 Zrinka Vrabec-Mojzes held the position of Editor in Chief of Radio 101. Since 1998-2010. she has been working as Anchor and Editor of Eurointegration programmes on Radio 101, hosting political radio shows and interviews.

The Croatian President Ivo Josipović in February 2010. appointed her as an Advisor for Social Affairs and until the end of his Presidential term in 2015. she has been working in the Office of the President. In her duty she covered wide range of fields – from culture, education, human rights, civil society, to media, which are her speciality. From 2015.-2018. she was hosting political talk-show on regional television TV Net.

From 2015. employed as columnist and journalist in Croatian political weekly NACIONAL.

She is a member of Croatian Journalist Association, where she was member of the Board from 1998-2002. She is also member of SEEMO – South East Europe Media Organization, a regional media organization based in Vienna, in which from 2009-2010. she acted as Vice-president.

During her career she was awarded by different prizes: in 1996 she was elected as «Women of the Year» by magazine «Zaposlena», in 1997 she was given «European Circle Prize» by European Movement Croatia, for contribution to the affirmation of European democratic values in Croatia. As a radio producer, she won the first prize on «FESTO» - Croatian Festival of Advertizing and Market Communication, for creation and the production of jingles and radio spots for the Croatian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the European Integrations. In year 2006 she awarded by the British Embassy in Zagreb for the show «The Alphabet

of the European Integrations», sharing the first prize for the best radio show dealing with the European topics. In the same year she also won «Robert Schuman» Award by Croatian Journalist Association and the Delegation of the European Commission in Croatia for the show «The Alphabet of the European Integrations», as the best radio show dealing with the European topics. In 2007 she was given the medal «Hrvatski pleter» by the President of the Republic, Mr Stjepan Mesić for the contribution in building democratic values in Croatia. In 2015. she was decorated by the President of the Republic, Mr Ivo Josipović, for promotion of Croatian culture in the country and abroad
